Sudbury veterinarian elected president of the College of Veterinarians of Ontario (CVO)

Dr. Beverly Baxter has been elected president of the College of Veterinarians of Ontario. The college is the provincial regulatory and licensing body for Ontario's 3900 veterinarians.

Dr. Baxter graduated from the Ontario Veterinary College in 1986. After graduation Dr. Baxter worked as an associate in companion animal practice before opening her own practice in Sudbury.

This is Dr. Baxter's fourth year on council. She has served on the Executive and Registration Committees and served as Chair of the Discipline Committee.

The College of Veterinarians of Ontario (CVO) regulates the practice of veterinary medicine in Ontario to protect the public interest. The CVO licenses veterinarians, inspects and accredits veterinary facilities and investigates complaints against veterinarians. The CVO also establishes and maintains standards of practice.
