

Provision of Pro Bono Veterinary Services to Homeless Population

It is the policy of the council of the College of Veterinarians of Ontario that veterinarians who wish to provide pro bono veterinary services to the homeless population, in a given location, from a companion animal mobile, must meet the requirements for accreditation of a companion animal mobile and may approach the college for an exemption to the CVO policy Companion Animal Mobile Services Locations.
